Costs

The Family Gathering will cost £5 per adult. Children under 12 will be free.

A BBQ will be held from 5 pm, and tickets will cost £5 per adult, and £2.50 for children under 12.

Publications

Three books are now available for purchase on Lulu, a publishing-on-demand website (http://www.lulu.com/). If you are unsure of which book includes your family, e-mail us at pask@one-name.org, and we will confirm which book is applicable to your family.

If you would like to purchase any of these book, but prefer not to do so using the internet, contact us and we will purchase the books on your behalf. All book prices do not include postage. The books take approximately 5-10 days to be printed and despatched. They are also available for immediate download if preferred for £3.50.

All books contain information on the Pask, Paske One-Name Study and a full index by surname and christian names of the people mentioned in the book.

PASKs of Suffolk Volume I – Wickhambrook

This book covers some of the descendants of John & Mirabel Pask née Sparrow, the main Suffolk progenitors. This book focuses on the descendants of their eldest son John, and his wife Catherine Pask née Kippen.

In this book there are detailed charts for the main families, minibiographies of approximately 830 people, together with 170 photographs.

Available in black & white it costs £7.96

PASKs of Suffolk Volume II – Wickhambrook

This book is the second part of the descendants of John & Mirabel Pask née Sparrow, the main Suffolk progenitors. This book focuses on the descendants of their second son Daniel, and his wives Elizabeth Pask née Manning, and Mary Pask née Peachey.

In this book there are detailed charts for the main families, minibiographies of approximately 500 people, together with 30 photographs. Available in black & white it costs £6.85

Unfortunately, only these five books will be completed in time for the Family Gathering in July.

PASKs of Great Gonerby Lincolnshire

This book covers the PASKs of Great Gonerby in Lincolnshire Ä the descendants of John & Alice Pask née Woodcock who settled in Great Gonerby in the early 1790s.

This book consists of 147 pages with detailed charts for the main families, minibiographies of approximately 350 people, together with 110 photographs. Available in black & white it costs £6.91; In superb colour it costs £18.23 Please note: This book will change it's title to PASKs of

PASKs of Monmouthshire Volume I & II (available June)

The initial research for this area was extensive, and assisted by Paula Payne, and Sylvia Rycroft we have now consolidated the information of the following families:

Descendants of two brothers Isaac & William Pask, who lived in Cwmcarvan and Llanvihangelystern-Llewern in the mid 1700s (1000+descendants, as detailed in Chart 4). This will be split into two books.

Descendants of Philip (1768-1843) & Phoebe Pask née Lewis who lived in Bryngwyn, Monmouthshire (120+ descendants, as detailed in Chart 34)
