this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following  
that is to say first and principally I committ my soul into  
the hands of Almighty God my heavenly Father hoping and  
assuredly being in the name of his Son Jesus Christ to obtain  
a full and free remission of all my sins and to be godly  
renewed into Eternal Glory my body I committ to the earth  
to return a decent interment according to the direction of my  
Executors herein after named And as to that temporal Estate  
which God of his infinite mercy hath above my dearest  
hath blessed me withal I give and bequeath the same  
as followeth In witness I give and bequeath unto my dearest  
and loving Father Mr. Samuel Cowls and Mr. Mart M.  
Leys the summe of five pounds a piece to buy them mourning  
them all the rest and residue of my Estate both real and  
personal I give devise and bequeath unto my dear and  
loving Children Anna Duxay and Anna Phillips to  
be equally divided between them share and share alike and  
to be paid unto my Sons James and Duxay at their  
respective ages of One and Twenty years And unto my  
said Daughter Anna at the age of One and Twenty  
years or day of marriage And in case of the death of  
any of them before they shall arrive the said age of One  
and Twenty years or day of marriage as aforesaid Then  
I will and bequeath the same unto the survivor or survivor  
of them And my Will and meaning is that in case of the  
death of all my said Children before they shall attain the  
age of One and Twenty years or day of marriage as  
aforesaid Then I will and bequeath unto my said Father  
Mr. Samuel Cowls and Mr. Mart M. Leys the summe of  
One hundred pounds In trust nevertheless that they shall pay  
and dispose the same unto my dear and loving Aunt Mr.  
Sarah Stevens Widow and her Children at such time or  
times and in such manner and proportion as they shall  
think most meet and convenient And also in case of death  
as aforesaid I further give unto my loving Aunt Anna  
Oriss the summe of six pounds per Ann for and during the  
time of her natural life Item and Lastly in case of the  
death as aforesaid of all my Children I give and bequeath  
all the residue and remainder of my Estate unto my dear  
and loving Brothers and Sisters to be equally divided between  
them share and share alike And I do hereby make and  
ordain my said loving Father Mr. Samuel Cowls and Mr.  
Mart M. Leys the only Executors of this my last Will and  
Testament hereby revoking all former or other Wills by  
me heretofore made In witness whereof to this my last  
Will and Testament contained in these two sheets of paper

Gentleman do make this my last Will and Testament in manner  
and term following. In witness I committ my soul into the hands of

the alone merits of my most blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus  
Christ And as for my worldly Goods which it hath pleased God  
to bless me with I give and bequeath in manner and form aforesaid  
following In witness I will and bequeath unto my now dear &  
wife George Park the disclaiming all pretensions to her Children  
one moiety of my Estate not exceeding Two hundred pounds  
per ann and legit charge for and during her natural life to be paid  
her half yearly vizt. Michaelmas and Lady day the first payment  
of the one half of the said moiety on the feast day of payment  
next after my decease And I also give her all my household  
goods and dinner and also the use of all my plate during her  
life And in case all my Children but one should happen to dye  
before marriage or before they arrive at the age of One and  
Twenty years I likewise give to her for and during her natural  
life one fourth part of the other moiety of my Estate Item  
I will and bequeath unto my dearest Aunt three hundred  
pounds One hundred pounds each with half a years interest  
that shall be due on them at the Michaelmas or Lady day first  
after my decease Provided I have not paid her the same in

my life time. Item I give and bequeath Twenty Armes Adowm  
shires to the Widows and Orphans of the poor Clergy of the  
Church of England Diet the yearly dividends of our Almstry of  
them to the poor Widows and the other for Appretiating as  
many Boys and Girls as the Dividens of them will amount to.  
And I do byt by request the Reverend Doctor Dunford the Chap  
Doctor Dunford and the Recyderant Dunstough to dispose the  
same as they shall think fit & out after the death of any two of  
them I desire the survivor will put the said Estate into the  
bands of the Corporation for the Charity to the Widows of the  
poor Clergy Item I give to the poor of the Parish where I  
shall happen to dye fifty Shillings and fifty Shillings to the poor  
of the Parish where I am buried if I be not buried in the same  
Parish where I dye Item I will and bequeath all the residue  
of my Estate after my debts are paid and funeral expences  
discharged unto the Child or Children it shall please God to  
bless me with in even and equal proportions whether they be  
sons or Daughters provided my Eldest son if it please God to  
bless me with more than one be not hereby excluded from  
solely inheriting his Mothers Rent charge as above as also  
my Plate &c after my Wifes decease lastly I do hereby constitute  
and appoint my deare wife Francis Paste sole Executrix of  
this my last Will and Testament Revoking all former Wills &  
& o whose Motherly care I committ the Child or Children  
it shall please God to bless me with and the managment  
of their fortunes so long as she liveth a widow & but in case she  
marryes again I do hereby leave the Guardianship of our said  
Child or Children to the Reverend Doctor Dunford the Rever  
Doctor Bedford and the Reverend Dr Dunstough and the  
survivor of them and also the sole managment of his person  
and Estates whose kind assistance I do hereby earnestly beg  
in that matter Item I do hereby ordene and appoint that the  
Child or Children shall please God to bless me with should equally  
inherit one another's fortunes if any of them happen to dye  
before marriage or before they arrive at the age of One  
and Twenty years and if it please God to take to himself  
any Child or Children before marriage or before he she  
or they arrive at the age of One and Twenty years I do  
hereby make my loving Brother Thomas Paste Esq and  
his Sons both mine his heirs and their sole Heirs only in  
such case I do hereby further give to my dear wife the Almstry  
of the survivors part during her natural life as aforesaid that  
being the heads and sume of my Will I desire and require all  
my relations as they will answer the contrary before Almighty  
God to acquiece in the plain sense and meaning of the same if  
it please God to take me before I make another Will in  
better method In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my

in possession or exception in law or equity by the Will of her  
deceased Father Benjamin Watson Esq or otherwise to all  
lands and hereditaments whatsoever at Northotenden or elsewhere  
in the County of Gloucester and do hereby ratify and confirm  
my said deare Wifes maintenance of five hundred pounds per  
annum provided by my marriage Settlement for her during her  
life and charged upon my Estate at Northotenden aforesaid  
or elsewhere in the said County of Essex and which my Will is  
that she shall be paid without any abatement whatsoever for  
by reason of any manner of taxes whatsoever by Parliament  
or otherwise and I desire to my said wife for and during  
her life without impeachment of wast my House situated by the  
Lane of Northotenden aforesaid in the said County of Essex with the  
outhouses Stables and all Outhouses and all Gardens and  
Orchards thereto belonging together with five Acres of Land and  
as my said wife shall thinke adjoyning to the said House and Gardens  
and Orchards with privilege of cutting down the timber of any part  
of my said Estate in Essex for such reparations and improvements  
in or about the said House Outhouses Gardens and Orchards  
as she my said wife shall thinke fitting to make and of cutting and  
taking such wood for felling as she shall thinke good to use in the said  
House and I desire further to her my said wife one yearly  
payement of annual summe off five hundred and five pounds  
of lawfull money of Great Britain to be paid her for and
